

Tutor Readiness Assessment Checklist for Educators

Use this checklist to evaluate whether tutoring candidates—and your program—are ready for high-impact academic success.



PROGRAM PLANNING & STRUCTURE

- A defined tutoring schedule is finalized (daily/weekly sessions).
- Tutoring sessions are integrated into the school day or offered with flexible time slots (before/after school).
- The tutoring model is designed for quarterly review and adjustment.
- Remote tutoring options are considered to expand the applicant pool.



RECRUITMENT CHANNELS & SOURCING

- Active listings are posted on Handshake (for college students/recent grads).
- Job postings are live on platforms like Indeed (for experienced professionals).
- Outreach includes untapped pipelines such as military spouses or retirees.
- Recruitment messaging highlights flexibility, mission-driven work, and development opportunities.



CANDIDATE READINESS & EVALUATION

- Mission alignment – The candidate expresses passion for educational equity and student growth.
- Resilience & adaptability – They've overcome challenges or supported others through change.
- Self-awareness – They can speak to their strengths, areas for growth, and what students need.
- Collaboration skills – They're comfortable working with teachers, administrators, and students.
- Cultural competency – They respect student differences and show empathy.
- Math-specific roles – The candidate demonstrates verified subject-matter proficiency.



ONBOARDING & BACKGROUND CHECK PREPAREDNESS

- Candidate is aware of the district's background check process and timelines.
- You have a separate, streamlined onboarding process for tutors (vs. full-time teachers).
- You've clearly communicated the onboarding expectations and required paperwork.



SCHOOL READINESS & SUPPORT SYSTEMS

- Tutors will receive training in classroom management and social-emotional learning.
- Staff (especially teachers) understand the tutoring program and welcome tutor involvement.
- Tutors are coached on how to guide student thinking rather than provide answers.
- There is a clear line of communication between tutors, teachers, and school leaders.
- Tutor feedback is collected and used to continuously improve the program.



FOR SCALING UP

- You have a dedicated recruitment and onboarding team.
- Workforce planning includes proactive hiring cycles and pipeline management.
- You're prepared to support tutors from diverse backgrounds, including those unfamiliar with the U.S. education system.
